

# Work Parties on the river banks

## Hazard Identified

Footfall damage to site

The manual handling of equipment tools and materials

Use of hand and power tools

Debris from old stagings must be removed with care

## Action to be taken to minimise risk

The minimum number of persons should be utilised for the work in hand bearing in mind Health Safety Issues ie lifting heavy weights  
Access to the river bank and work area to be made using the established pathways from the car park / hardstanding

Experienced members of the club familiar with the work in hand to supervise inexperienced members of the work party

All tools are inspected and must be in good condition before use.  
230/240 volt tools are not to be used on the riverbank  
Low voltage and rechargeable tools and motorised tools only to be used by competent persons

Keep old debris to one side away from the work area until it can be safely removed back to the clubhouse for disposal  
Gloves and stout footwear must be worn by all personnel taking part in activity
